

Jean-Luc Jamet "L'enclave" ▪ France ▪ Côtes du Rhône

Jean-Luc Jamet is one of the most iconic producers of Côte-Rôtie and Côte du Rhône, home to the best Syrah the world has to offer. The "Enclave" cuvée comes from within the Côte-Rôtie appellation, from Bonnivières in the Côte Brune. Profound and dense wine, yet fresh and precise.

Rocollo Grassi "Valpolicella superiore" ▪ Italy ▪ Veneto

Valpolicella Superiore Rocollo Grassi is obtained from about 60% fresh grapes and 40% slightly dried grapes, 20-months matured in wooden barrels. It's an ambitious Valpolicella, of great complexity and personality.

Feudo Croce "Megale" ▪ Italy ▪ Puglia

This is a textbook example of a Salento Negroamaro. It shows a deep red color with a pleasant aroma consisting of fruity and spicy hints of cherries, plums and cinnamon. With 14% Alc. strength, it is a round and full wine, but with excellent drinkability.

Barbara Forés "Templari" ▪ Spain ▪ Catalunya

Morenillo is a nearly extinct variety that Maria Carme Ferrer started to replant in the late 90's. With this grape, matured here on clay amphorae, they manage to make a fresh and elegant wine in Terra Alta, the southernmost and hottest D.O. from Cataluña.

Paramos de nicasia ▪ Spain ▪ Castilla y leon

The vineyard is situated northeast of the Douro where, in addition to the typical Tinta de Toro, are quite a few old, pre-phylloxera Garnacha and Malvasia vines. The result is an intense, fruity and juicy Toro.

The inspiration for this wine came from a stubborn belief that Pinotage today has its place among more established varieties. The result is a fruity and elegant wine with an interesting complexity, made in the style of a nice Beaujolais Grand Cru.
